Pete Love is an accomplished singer/songwriter and a much sought-after guitarist who is comfortable playing most genres of music from acoustic, blues to rock and roll. Sometimes referred to as Mr. Jukebox for his wealth of instant musical recall, Pete Love has played with groups such as the Denny Phillips Band, Spectrum, Band in the Park, Mary Davis and Co., The Navigators and Smokin' Gun. Pete self-produced his CD "Chester and the Elements." You'll often find Pete with The Midtown Pickers Wednesday evenings at the Coffee Deli and his usual haunts on Tybee Island.



Hanson & Amburgey

Michael Amburgey and Bobby Hanson comprise acoustic blues duo that began their collaboration in 1972. Pioneers of the Coastal Empire's burgeoning blues and rock scene, Michael and Bobby were a major influence on many Savannah musicians of their genre and era. They carried on the tradition of their musical heroes while developing their own musical tradition. Their music is mixture of humor, gospel, ballads, rags, and blues. Hanson & Amburgey only play a few shows per year so we're fortunate to have them for First Friday concert.
